

## May Park Primary Uniform Policy

At May Park we believe that wearing the same uniform further demonstrates the harmonious nature of our school - we are ONE community. Our uniform reflects our pride in our school.

### Our Main School Uniform consists of:

- Navy Blue Sweater, Cardigan, School Fleece with the May Park Primary School Logo
- Plain White Polo Shirt (with or without school logo)
- Black or Grey Pinafore, Skirt, Shorts or Trousers
- Hijabs (Navy Blue, White, Black)
- Black School Shoes or Trainers.
- Navy blue gingham summer dress
- Jewellery is limited to one pair of ear studs only

### Our School PE Kit

For health and safety and modesty reasons, we ask that all children wear the correct clothing for all PE activities. **Clothing should not be loose in order to prevent it from catching on equipment.**

- White T-shirt (long or short sleeve)
- Navy blue leggings or jogging bottoms (navy blue shorts may also be worn)
- Black daps or trainers for all other indoor activities

We also ask that all long hair is tied back during PE. Staff will ensure that earrings are covered with tape and any other jewellery is removed for the duration of the session.

### For Outdoors PE

Due to our fantastic outdoor space we may require additional items of outdoor kit depending on the weather conditions. During the cold weather the children may wear a jumper/hoodie (any colour) in order to stay warm. They will also require outdoor trainers.

### Woodland Play and Forest School

- Children should have clothing appropriate for the weather conditions.

Branded school uniform items should be ordered and paid for through our suppliers Gooddies ([www.gooddies.co.uk](http://www.gooddies.co.uk)) You can choose to either have items delivered to your home address for a small delivery fee or to the school office free of charge.

### Equipment for Learning

A part of our school uniform is being prepared for learning. To encourage our children to be responsible and prepared for school we also ask that all children come to school equipped with a **school bag or book bag** so that reading books/records can be transported home safely.

In **Years 5 & 6** to support the transition to Secondary School we also required children to have a pencil case containing the following items of stationery

- Pencils
- Eraser
- Ruler
- Handwriting pen (no gel pens)
